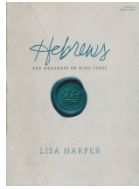

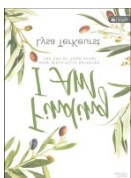
PRESENT OVER PERFECT: Leaving Behind Frantic For A Simpler, More Soulful Way of Living (Shauna Niequist Study)

FINDING I AM: How Jesus Fully Satisfies the Cry of Your Heart (Lysa Terkeurst Study)

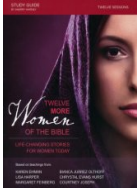
