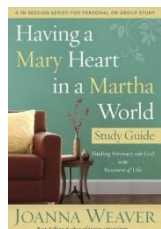

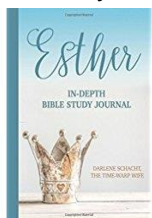

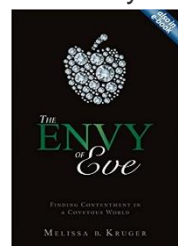
- Comparison, envy, and entitlement often stop us from pulling out a chair at the table. Friendship can be hard....

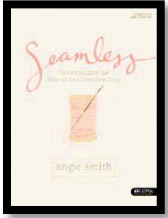

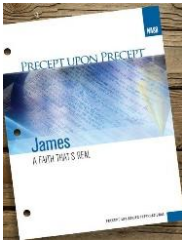

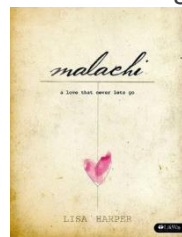
