


WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDIES ~ FALL 2019


Discerning the Voice of God (Priscilla Shirer)


1 Peter: A Living Hope in Christ (Jen Wilkin) – Ends Dec. 11

Redeemed: Seeing the Messiah in the Book of Ruth (Dr. Sam Nadler)


